MBS SENIOR FUNDRAISER


Seniors are selling homemade candles for their senior trip fundraiser. If you would like to make a purchase visit MBS 2021 Senior

SPORTS SPECTATORS

Due to many of the guidelines this year, each facility/team we play has a little bit different rule in place. This is based much on gym size as well as a few other school factors. I will try to break this down as easy as I can:

<u>Ojibwe Charter School</u> allows 2 spectators per athlete playing. When you enter the facility, you have to sign in under an athlete.

<u>Big Bay de Noc</u> allows 150 spectators total-75 per team. This is a first come-first serve basis. To put that in perspective, we have 8 athletes. If 2 parents come, that only gives us 16 spectators so we have quite a bit more allowed if other family members would like to attend.

<u>Hannahville Schools</u> allow 250 total in their gym with first come-first serve. That is quite a bit if you would like to bring a few more people with you (kids, siblings, grandparents).

<u>Maplewood Baptist</u> is around the 250 mark as well. They are less strict on a number capacity.

All facilities require masks to be worn for athletes, coaches, and spectators. Please be mindful of that.
