MBS SENIOR FUNDRAISER

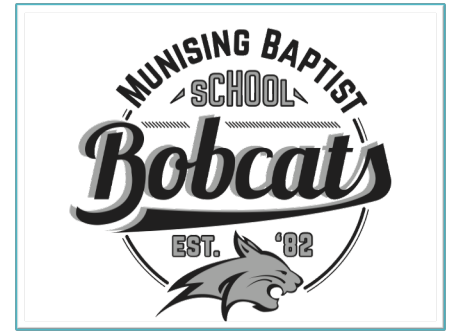

Big Bay de Noc allows 150 spectators total- 75 per team. This is a first come-first serve basis. To put that in perspective, we have 8 athletes. If 2 parents come, that only gives us 16 spectators so we have quite a bit more allowed if other family members would like to attend.

Hannahville Schools allow 250 total in their gym with first come-first serve. That is quite a bit if you would like to bring a few more people with you (kids, siblings, grandparents).
