# Munising Baptist School Statement of Cooperation (2023-2024) — one per student

# In making application to Munising Baptist School, I understand the following:

I agree to support the goal of Christian education at Munising Baptist School: to train each student to the height of his academic ability and to encourage him to develop a personal relationship with Jesus Christ to the point where the heart is yielded to His control.

### FINANCIAL GUIDELINES

- 1. I understand that the Registration Fee is non-refundable if my child is accepted.
- 2. It is my responsibility as a parent/guardian to pay tuition as stated on the current financial form.
- 3. I realize that late fees will be assessed if my tuition is not paid by the proper due date.
- 4. I understand that students with delinquent accounts will be subject to suspension and/or dismissal.
- 5. In the event my account is submitted to a collection agency, I assume the responsibility of all charges incurred.
- 6. In the event a student transfers to another school, transcripts/records will not be released until the tuition and fees are paid in full.

## DISCIPLINE GUIDELINES

- 1. The school reserves the right to dismiss any student who is found to be out of harmony with the rules and policies of Munising Baptist School. Expulsion may result if a student engages in conduct that violates biblical principles, dishonors God, or casts a poor reflection on the reputation of the school.
- 2. I believe that discipline is necessary for the welfare of each student, as well as for the entire school. I give permission for my child's teacher and/or the administration of the school to make and enforce classroom regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles.
- 3. The teachers and administration are hereby given full discretion in the discipline of my child. Disciplinary means may include loss of privileges, detentions, demerits, assignments, suspensions, and possibly expulsion.

# **ACADEMIC GUIDELINES**

- 1. The administration of the school has the final responsibility for the grade placement of my child.
- 2. I agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of Munising Baptist School by providing a place at home for my child to study and by encouraging academic responsibility.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- 1. I give Munising Baptist School permission for my child to take part in all school activities, including school sponsored trips and sporting activities. Should I have concerns about an activity; the concerns will be addressed to the administration for proper evaluation.
- 2. I absolve the school, its employees, and volunteers harmless from liability to me or my child at school or during school activities of any accidents that take place under reasonable supervision.
- 3. Should there be any questions or concerns involving the school, we agree to contact the teacher or administration, and we agree to follow the principles found in Matthew 18:15-17, which says to go directly to the person with whom there is a difference and settle the difference before believers.
- 4. I will not go to the law before unbelievers (1 Corinthians 6:1) for any reason, including injury and liability. I do agree to submit irreconcilable differences with MBS to arbitration before mutually acceptable believers. I will not be critical of the administration or teachers in the presence of my child.
- 5. If a problem with the school cannot be remedied, we agree to quietly withdraw our child from the school rather than encourage discord or unrest among other parents.
- 6. I will regularly pray for and support the faculty, staff, and the administration of MBS as they minister to the spiritual and educational needs of all enrolled students.

I understand that this is a legally binding agreement and that it cannot be altered by any party without the written consent of the other parties. I have read the above information and the School Handbook and agree to cooperate with Munising Baptist School concerning these guidelines involving the education of my child.
